



SPI Assessment Prerequisites

- You have successfully completed an AMGA Single Pitch Instructor course.
- Are a current member of the AMGA.
- You have trad lead climbed a minimum of 40 rock climbing routes. A large number of these should be at 5.6 or higher and hopefully on a variety of rock types.
- You are capable of comfortably lead climbing 5.6 traditional routes (leader placing protection). You will demonstrate your leading ability on a variety of routes on the assessment.
- You are capable of comfortably climbing 5.8 while on a top rope.

The SPI Assessment can be taken directly following the SPI Course if the candidate successfully completed the course and meets the Assessment prerequisites. However, it is highly recommended that the SPI Course candidate takes time practicing and consolidating the skills learned on the course before assessment.
